Lent begins this **Ash Wednesday**, **March 6th** with a <u>Divine Service at 7pm</u>. On Ash Wednesday, we are marked with the ashes of last year's palms from Palm Sunday. The ashes are imposed as a sign of contrition and repentance. We remember our sin, and we remember the curse of sin which is death. Dust we are, and to dust we shall return. But the ashes are also marked in the shape of a cross, reminding us of the one who took our sin and death and defeated them, that, we might have forgiveness and life through him.
