Synod News

LCMS President Elected. This year is the Synodical Triennium with the LCMS Convention in Tampa, Fla., later in July. Now, the Synod President is elected by an online ballot cast before the convention begins. This voting process happened this past week, June 22-25th. Each congregation casts two votes: a pastoral and a lay delegate representing each congregation. In our cast at St. Paul, the voting delegates were Pr. Yeager and Mike Hoffman, our congregational chairman. We were pleased to vote for Rev. Matthew Harrison the incumbent, who is a theologian faithful to the Lutheran Confessions and has faithfully led our Synod for 9 years. The results are in: President Matthew Harrison was reelected on the first ballot with 51 percent of the vote. We will continue to name Pr. Harrison in our prayers each week, beseeching the Lord of the Church to bless him and our Synod.
