The Second Sunday of Advent, we meditate upon the Holy Gospel from Matthew 3:1-12, which gives us the ministry of John the Baptist, the last of the Old Testament prophets and the Lord's forerunner, sent to prepare the way of Jesus. Advent is a season of preparation.
