The First Sunday in Lent gives us the Gospel from Matthew 4:1-11, Jesus tempted by Satan in the wilderness. The first Adam was tempted and fell through the devil's temptation (Old Testament). But God promises a Savior: the Seed of the woman come to crush the serpent's head. This is why the Son of God appeared in human flesh: to destroy the works of the devil (1 Jn. 3:8).

His perfect obedience for us involves being tempted, just as we are tempted, for he must be like unto us in every way in order to stand in for us as our perfect Substitute. Jesus Christ resists temptation by holding fast in perfect faith to the Word of God. Therefore, by the disobedience of one man-Adam, the many were made sinners. By the obedience of another man-Jesus Christ, many are made righteous (Epistle). Whereas the fruit of one tree brought sin and death to all mankind, so the fruit of another tree- the holy cross where our Savior died, life and salvation come to all mankind. In Christ, we find not only our righteousness and redemption, but we also find in him an example when we ourselves are likewise tempted. How is the Satanic foe repulsed? Through the faith that takes hold of the Word in all things, and trusts the Word as the source of all wisdom, enlightenment, and eternal life.
