NEWS AND NOTES | March 15th, 2020

At St. Paul, Preble.

The Third Sunday in Lent gives us the Gospel from St. John 5:4-26. In the town of Sychar of Samaria, Jesus meets a woman by Jacob's well. It is high noon, and Jesus is thirsty. He asks the woman for a drink. It was the height of all scandal that Jesus would have been speaking with a woman, let alone a Samaritan woman. She is surprised at Jesus' request. Jesus says, if she would have known who it was who asked her for water, she would have asked him, and he would have given her living water. The water of which Jesus speaks is the water that is joined with God's Spirit, the life-giving water of God's divine mercy, rich in grace, poured out in order to join sinners to Christ—the one from whose pierced side living water flowed out upon the holy cross, together with his blood. The woman has a checkered past. She has had five husbands, and the man she is currently with is not her husband. Christ, the omniscient Son of God knows this, along with every facet of her pained life. He has crossed the many boundaries that separated him from this woman, because he would be her true husband, the Bridegroom of all the fallen children who have played the harlot and wandered from God. The time is coming, Jesus says, when God will not be worshipped in Jerusalem or on any mountain of Samaria, but wherever the Holy Spirit is present with the living water of salvation, there is God the Father present in worship for the saints.

During Lent, Pastor Yeager invites the members of St. Paul to meet with him in order to privately confess those sins which weigh heavy on the heart and conscience, and to receive Absolution, that is, God's forgiveness.
